

SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES

1. Applications due April 1, 2022

I.M (Brick) Robb Fellowship

This fellowship is named in honour of I.M. (Brick) Robb, teacher and Head of Guidance at Northern Vocational School, Toronto, until appointed Field and Deputy General Secretary of OSSTF/FEESO in 1950. He served as General Secretary from 1964 to 1968. This fellowship is designed to assist OSSTF/FEESO Members in good standing with Doctoral studies at a university of their choice in the amount of \$3500.

Dr. S.G.B Robinson Travelling Grant

The Dr. S.G.B. Robinson Travelling Grant was established in 1965 in recognition of the contribution made by Dr. Robinson in moulding OSSTF/FEESO through its formative years. Dr. Robinson, fondly known as "Steve," served on the Secretariat for 24 years as an Assistant Secretary and as General Secretary during the 19 years prior to his retirement in 1964. The grant, in an amount up to \$3500, shall provide the opportunity for an OSSTF/FEESO Member in good standing to travel, during the upcoming academic year, for the purpose of serving education. More than one grant in a year is possible.

J.W. Ansley Grant for Educational Research

J.W. Ansley, Principal of York Memorial Collegiate Institute, for many years was an outstanding teacher and a member of this Federation. The Ansley Memorial Lecture Series was established in 1954 in his memory and has been replaced by the J.W. Ansley Grant for Educational Research. The purpose of this grant is to support research projects of a practical nature, which are currently topical and the results of which will primarily benefit the classroom practitioner and/or educational programs or curriculum. The grant may be any sum up to \$3,500, and more than one grant in a year is possible.

OSSTF/FEESO Educational Enhancement Funds

The purpose of the Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation Educational Enhancement Grant is to assist OSSTF/FEESO Members in good standing with their studies. The grant may be any sum up to \$3,500, and more than one grant in a year is possible.



S. Hunter Henry Grant

The grant is named in honour of S. Hunter Henry, one of the 62 delegates who attended an inaugural meeting of OSSTF/FEESO on December 30, 1919. He was General Secretary from 1923 to 1945. He served as principal of Barrie Collegiate from 1916 to 1918 and then became head of mathematics at Central High School of Commerce in Toronto. The purpose of the grant is to assist financially OSSTF/FEESO Members in good standing with studies at a publicly-funded university or college of their choice that leads to a degree, diploma, or certificate (except in Doctoral studies). A maximum of \$3,500 is available.

2. Applications due April 15, 2022

Federation Family Education Fund

The Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation (OSSTF/FEESO) established the Federation Family Education Fund (FFEF) to assist financially the children of OSSTF/FEESO members in good standing in the year of application to obtain their first degree/diploma/certificate or apprenticeship. Bursaries are awarded through a lottery process and are conditional upon the recipient being enrolled in the program and proof of tuition paid equal to or greater than the value of the bursary. The award is a one-time grant of 1,500.
